ABOUT THE PHOTOGRAPHER

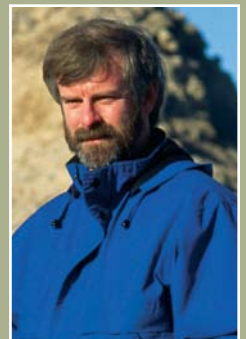
